College Policy on Solid Waste Management

- College shall maintain three types of segregation of waste, namely biodegradable waste (wet waste), non-biodegradable waste (dry waste) and ewaste.
- Three major dustbins will be used for collecting above mentioned wastes.
- Offices, departments and students are directed to use their dustbins only for dry waste. Keep other wastes in major dustbin.
- All the dry waste shall be collected and destroyed at the identified place in the campus.
- All the biodegradable wastes shall be deposited in the vermi-compost pit of the college.
- E-waste shall be given to the specific vendor, when collected in good amount.
- Plastics (if any) shall be separated at the time of disposed off.

College Policy on Energy Conservation

- Only LED tube lights and bulbs shall be used in the college campus.
- Offices, departments and students are directed to put off lights and fans, when not in use.
- Solar panels of 10 kW shall be used for electricity back up.
- College shall not use generator and inverter for power back up.
- Power line shall not be attached with solar electricity.
- All the smart classrooms shall have solar power back up.
- All the teaching and non-teaching staffs are requested to pool and share vehicles for coming to college.

College Policy on Water Conservation

- College has separate tanks for drinking water and wash room water supply.
- Tank for drinking water shall be connected with direct supply line.
- Water filter and cooler shall be maintained through Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC).
- After rainy season drinking water tank shall be cleaned.
- Rain water harvesting system has been installed in college campus.
- The water collected in the rain water harvesting tank shall be used for wash rooms or gardening.
- Teaching, non-teaching staffs and students are directed to close the taps, when not in use.
- Presently rain water harvesting system is available only for main building. In future it may be extended for the RUSA building also.
- There are set of separate toilets for staffs and students having male and female toilets at each floor. Each set has one toilet for Diyangjan at middle floor.
- All the college staffs and students are requested to use the toilet allotted for them.

College Policy on Green Campus

- College shall maintain green belt in front of main building of college campus as potted plants.
- A small green area shall be maintained as flower bed in parking area.
- The empty land of campus shall be used for plantation of trees.
- Plantation shall be done in rainy and winter season in collaboration with forest department and horticulture department.
- NSS unit shall develop and maintain Herbal Garden.
- Time to time teaching, non-teaching staffs and students shall devote their time in maintain greenery in the campus.
- The compost formed in college vermi-compost pit shall be used in plantation activity.
- During cleanliness drive in the campus, all the cut down bushes shall be disposed off in compost pit.

College Policy on Green Practices

- Complete ban on single use plastic in college campus.
- All the teaching, non-teaching staffs and students are directed to use only paper cup, paper glass, paper plate and wooden spoon in any program, if required.
- In seminars/workshops, instead of purchasing plastic bottle of mineral water, water from filter shall be stored in stainless steel bottles and shall be served in glass tumbler.
- Instead of bouquet, potted plant shall be gifted to guests.
- Offices and departments shall be promoted to keep potted plants in their working surrounding.

College Policy on Beyond Campus Environment Promotion Activities

- Several activities promoting the clean environment shall be undertaken by college as awareness lectures, nukkad natak, awareness rally and cleanliness drive.
- These activities shall be conducted through NSS, Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Education Committees of the college.
- Any one department shall conduct one activity per month on the issues sanitation and hygiene, solid waste management, energy conservation, water conservation and greenery.
- Outreach activities shall be performed in collaboration of other Government agencies/NGOs.
- Students shall be given field based assignments.
- All the teaching, non-teaching staffs and students shall participate in such activities.
